Representation of the Attorney General pursuant to Article 5 of the Loi (1937) sur l'atténuation des peines et sur la mise en liberté surveillée.

On 10th June, 1994, the accused pleaded guilty to:

- 1 count of aiding/assisting/participating in illegal entry and larceny (count 1A of the indictment laid against him and his co-accused).
- 3 counts of illegal entry and larceny (counts 2, 3, 4).
- 4 counts of larceny (counts 5, 7, 8, 9).
- 1 count of attempted larceny (count 6).

The accused was placed on probation for 1 year, on condition he complete 100 hours of community service. The Crown asked that the Probation Order be discharged and the following sentences be substituted:

- Counts 1A,2,3,4,7: 3 months' imprisonment, on each count, concurrent.
- Counts 5,6,8: 3 weeks' imprisonment, on each count, concurrent.
- Count 9: 2 weeks' imprisonment, on each count, concurrent.

The Court grants Crown's conclusions.

JUDGMENT

THE DEPUTY BAILIFF: Cole, on 10th June, 1995, we gave you a chance. You might say that we took a risk. Community service is not a soft option and you will recall that the Order reads "and if you fail to observe any of the conditions of your recognizance you are

likely to be apprehended and to be sentenced to the offences for which you have pleaded guilty".

5 Over 18 months there are still 70 hours of community service
outstanding out of the 100 that we ordered you to serve. Mr.
Seymour, the Community Service Officer, has not been able to give
us any encouragement. We cannot blow hot and cold. Therefore we
are going to have to call in the Community Service Order and on
counts 1A, 2, 3, 4 & 7, you are sentenced to 3 months'
10 imprisonment; on counts 5, 6 & 8, you are sentenced to 3 weeks'
imprisonment, concurrent; on count 9, you are sentenced to 2
weeks' imprisonment, concurrent; making a total of 3 months'
imprisonment.
