JUDGMENT

THE DEPUTY BAILIFF: The seriousness of this offence alone would normally make this application quite hopeless. However, the fact that Miss Coutanche has been remanded on a warning since 23rd June of last year and is continuing with her rehabilitation programme allows us to take an exceptional view.

Miss Fitz, we would say this: this must not be taken as any indication that the eventual trial will not incur a prison sentence. Miss Coutanche, you are remanded on a warning until your trial on 11th April, 1997.
