**The Addition of Vitamins, Minerals and Other Substances  
(Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2010**

*Made* - - - - *2nd September 2010*

*Coming into operation* - *1st October 2010*

The Department of Health, Social Services and Public Safety<sup>(a)</sup> makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by Articles 15(1)(a), (e) and (f), 16(2), 25(1)(a) and (3) and 47(2) of the Food Safety (Northern Ireland) Order 1991<sup>(b)</sup>, as read with paragraph 1A of Schedule 2 to the European Communities Act 1972<sup>(c)</sup>.

In accordance with Article 47(3A) of that Order, it has had regard to relevant advice given by the Food Standards Agency.

These Regulations make provision for a purpose mentioned in section 2(2) of the European Communities Act 1972 and it appears to the Department of Health, Social Services and Public Safety that it is expedient for references to the EU instrument mentioned in regulation 3 to be construed as references to that instrument as Annexes I and II to it may be amended from time to time.

As required by Article 9 of Regulation (EC) No. 178/2002 of the European Parliament and of the Council laying down the general principles and requirements of food law, establishing the European Food Safety Authority and laying down procedures in matters of food safety<sup>(d)</sup>, there has been open and transparent public consultation during the preparation and evaluation of these Regulations.

**Citation, commencement and interpretation**

1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Addition of Vitamins, Minerals and Other Substances (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2010 and come into operation on 1st October 2010.

(2) The Interpretation Act (Northern Ireland) 1954<sup>(a)</sup> shall apply to these Regulations as it applies to an Act of the Assembly.

**Amendment to the Addition of Vitamins, Minerals and Other Substances Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2007**

2. The Addition of Vitamins, Minerals and Other Substances Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2007<sup>(b)</sup> are amended in accordance with regulation 3.

3. In regulation 2(1) (interpretation) for the definition of “the EC Regulation” substitute —

““the EC Regulation” means Regulation (EC) No. 1925/2006 of the European Parliament and of the Council on the addition of vitamins and minerals and of certain other substances to foods, as Annex I or II to that Regulation may be amended from time to time;”<sup>(c)</sup>.

## **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

*(This note is not part of the Regulations)*

These Regulations amend the Addition of Vitamins, Minerals and Other Substances Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2007 (S.R. 2007 No. 301) to the effect that where those Regulations mention “the EC Regulation”, that reference will be ambulatory to a specified extent. Any such reference will be to Regulation (EC) No. 1925/2006 of the European Parliament and of the Council on the addition of vitamins and minerals and of certain other substances to foods (OJ No. L404, 30.12.2006, p.26) as that Regulation may be amended from time to time by changes made to its Annexes I or II. These Annexes have been previously amended by Commission Regulation (EC) No. 1170/2009 (OJ No. L314, 1.12.2009, p.36).
