Citation

1. This Order may be cited as the Civil Registration (2011 Act) (Commencement No.1) Order (Northern Ireland) 2011.

- **2.** The following provisions of the Civil Registration Act (Northern Ireland) 2011 shall come into operation on 3rd October 2011 -
 - (a) section 1(1), (2), (3)(a) and (5) (registration of births);
 - (b) section 5 (time limit on registration of still-births);
 - (c) section 6 (registration of still-births where parents not married);
 - (d) section 9(1), (2), (3), (4)(a) and (6) (registration of deaths);
 - (e) section 12 (discharge of functions of the Registrar General); and
 - (f) section 18 (issue of short birth certificate).
