**The North Circular Road and Tarry Lane, Lurgan
(Abandonment) Order (Northern Ireland) 2012**

Made - - - - - *6th February 2012*

Coming into operation - *14th March 2012*

The Department for Regional Development^(a) makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by Article 68(1) of the Roads (Northern Ireland) Order 1993^(b) and now vested in it^(c).

The Department in accordance with Article 68(4) of that Order is of the opinion that another road is available which provides alternative facilities for road traffic.

Notice has been published, served and displayed in compliance with paragraphs 1, 2 and 3 of Schedule 8 to that Order.

No objection has been received.

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as The North Circular Road and Tarry Lane, Lurgan (Abandonment) Order (Northern Ireland) 2012 and shall come into operation on 14th March 2012.

Application

2. The area of road described in the Schedule is abandoned.

Article 2

AREA OF ROAD TO BE ABANDONED

An area of 783 square metres of superseded road at North Circular Road, Lurgan commencing at a point 7.3 metres east of its junction with Tarry Lane and extending for a distance of 125.5 metres in a south-easterly direction more particularly delineated and shown hatched on Map No. 10/1/22/11.
