**The B122 Murley Road, Fivemiletown (Abandonment) Order
(Northern Ireland) 2016**

Made - - - - - *7th September 2016*

Coming into operation - *19th October 2016*

The Department for Infrastructure^(a) makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by Article 68(1) of the Roads (Northern Ireland) Order 1993^(b) and now vested in it^(c).

The Department in accordance with Article 68(4) of that Order proposes to abandon the area of road described in the Schedule as it is no longer necessary and another road is available which provides alternative facilities for road traffic.

Notice has been published, served and displayed in compliance with paragraphs 1, 2 and 3 of Schedule 8 to that Order.

No objection has been received.

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as The B122 Murley Road, Fivemiletown (Abandonment) Order (Northern Ireland) 2016 and shall come into operation on 19th October 2016.

Application

2. The area of road described in the Schedule is abandoned.

AREA OF ROAD TO BE ABANDONED
