The Loading Bays, Motor Hackney Carriages (Belfast) By-Laws, On-Street Parking and Urban Clearways (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 2017

Made - - - - *30th June 2017*

Coming into operation - *21st July 2017*

The Department for Infrastructure(a) makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by Articles 4(1), (2) and (3), 10(4), 13(1), 15(1) and 27A(1) of, and paragraph 5 of Schedule 4 to, the Road Traffic Regulation (Northern Ireland) Order 1997(b) and now vested in it(c).

It appears to the Department to be necessary to provide a suitable parking place for vehicles on the lengths of road specified in Article 3.

The Department has consulted such persons as it considered appropriate in compliance with paragraphs 1 and 2 of Schedules 1, 4 and 4A to the Road Traffic Regulation (Northern Ireland) Order 1997(d).

The Department has published a notice in compliance with paragraphs 1 and 3 of those Schedules.

The Department in compliance with paragraph 3(4) of Schedule 4 to that Order has taken such other steps as appear to the Department reasonably practicable for the purpose of bringing specifically to the knowledge of occupiers of land adjacent to the parking places the particulars specified in paragraph 3(2) of that Schedule.

Four objections have been received and duly considered and one representation has been received.

The Department has modified the draft Order.

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as The Loading Bays, Motor Hackney Carriages (Belfast) By-Laws, On-Street Parking and Urban Clearways (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 2017 and shall come into operation on 21st July 2017.

Amendments to Motor Hackney By-Laws

2.—(1) The By-Laws made in respect of Motor Hackney Carriages standing or plying for hire made by the Council of the County Borough of Belfast on 4th June 1951(a) shall be amended in accordance with paragraphs (2) and (3).

(2) For By-Law 9 substitute the following—

“9.—(1) The several streets specified in the first column of the Schedule to these By-laws annexed shall at the sites specified in column 2 of said Schedule be the prescribed public street stands for Motor Hackney Carriages not exceeding the number specified in the third column of the said Schedule.

(2) A vehicle other than a licensed Motor Hackney Carriage standing or plying for hire shall not at any time wait on any such prescribed public street stands.

(3) Nothing in Paragraph 2 shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a vehicle to wait on the carriageway of the length of road specified in item no. 3 of the Schedule relating to Botanic Avenue for so long as may be reasonably necessary to enable goods to be loaded or unloaded from the vehicle.”

(3) For the Schedule substitute the Schedule specified in the Schedule to this Order.

Amendments to Loading Bays Order

3.—(1) The Loading Bays on Roads Order (Northern Ireland) 2007(b) shall be amended in accordance with paragraphs (2) and (3).

(2) In Article 4 (exceptions) add the following—

“(c) a taxi using the loading bay in Botanic Avenue, Belfast (item no. 163) in accordance with The By-Laws made in respect of Motor Hackney Carriages standing or plying for hire made by the Council of the County Borough of Belfast on 4th June 1951.”

(3) In Schedule 1 add the following items—

“ 164.	Botanic Avenue, Belfast (east side) – from a point 15 metres south of the south kerbline of Posnett Street for a distance of 30 metres in a southerly direction.	All Hours	All Days
165.	Dublin Road, Belfast (east side in a lay-by) – from a point 5.3 metres north of its junction with Marcus Ward Street for a distance of 13.7 metres in a northerly direction.	All Hours	All Days”

Amendments to On-Street Parking Order

4. The On-Street Parking Order (Northern Ireland) 2000(c) is amended by the substitution for item no. 13 relating to Botanic Avenue (east side), item no. 18 relating to Bridge Street, item nos. 36 and 37 relating to Dublin Road (east and west sides) and item no. 48 relating to Great Victoria Street, from Fisherwick Place to Hope Street (east side), in Chapter 1, Part I of Schedule 1 of the same descriptions together with new maps.

69.	Donegall Square North, Belfast – both sides (but excluding the disabled bays on the north side).	8.00 a.m. to 9.30 a.m. and 4.30 p.m. to 6.00 p.m.	Monday to Friday inclusive”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order amends the By-Laws made in respect of Motor Hackney Carriages standing or plying for hire made by the Council of the County Borough of Belfast on 4th June 1951 by the substitution of the Schedule to include new stands at Botanic Avenue, Bridge Street and High Street and amend the description and operation of stands at Dublin Road and Great Victoria Street. It also amends the By-Laws to permit the use of the stand in Botanic Avenue for the purposes of loading and unloading.

The Order also amends The Loading Bays on Roads Order (Northern Ireland) 2007 (“the Loading Bays Order”) by the addition to Schedule 1 of the items specified in Article 3. The loading bays are for the use of all vehicles at any times. Article 4 to the Loading Bays Order is also amended to permit the use of the loading bay in Botanic Avenue by taxis.

The Order makes consequential amendments to the On-Street Parking Order (Northern Ireland) 2000 in relation to Botanic Avenue, Bridge Street, Dublin Road and Great Victoria Street and The Urban Clearways Order (Northern Ireland) 2016 in relation to Botanic Avenue and Donegall Square North.

A penalty charge (£90) is payable with respect to a vehicle involved in a contravention of the Order in accordance with the Traffic Management (Northern Ireland) Order 2005 and The Penalty Charges (Prescribed Amounts) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2006.
