## HARBOURS, DOCKS, ETC.

The Harbour Works (Environmental Impact Assessment) (Revocation) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2018

Made--20th November 2018Coming into operation14th January 2019

The Department for Infrastructure is a Northern Ireland department designated (1) for the purposes of section 2(2) of the European Communities Act 1972 in relation to the environment.

The Department for Infrastructure makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by section 2(2) of the European Communities Act 1972(2).

#### **Citation and commencement**

**1.** These Regulations may be cited as the Harbour Works (Environmental Impact Assessment) (Revocation) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2018 and come into operation on 14thJanuary 2019.

### Revocations

- 2. The following Regulations are revoked:-
  - (a) the Harbour Works (Environmental Impact Assessment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2003(3); and
  - (b) the Harbour Works (Environmental Impact Assessment) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2007(4).
