The Dundrod Circuit (Admission Charges) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2019

Made - - - - 18th June 2019
Coming into operation 16th July 2019

The Department for Infrastructure(1), in exercise of the powers conferred by Article 3(7A)(b) of the Road Races (Northern Ireland) Order 1986(2) and now exercisable by it(3), and of every other power enabling it in that behalf makes the following Regulations.

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as The Dundrod Circuit (Admission Charges) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2019 and shall come into operation on 16th July 2019.

Charges

2. The maximum charge for a spectator badge in respect of each person shall be £30.00.

Revocation

3. The Dundrod Circuit (Admission Charges) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2011(4) are revoked.
