## MENTAL CAPACITY

The Mental Capacity (Deprivation of Liberty) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2019

Made - - - - 13th September 2019
Laid before Assembly - - 16th September 2019
Coming into operation in accordance with regulation 1.

The Department of Health(1), in exercise of the powers conferred by paragraph 9 of Schedule 2 to the Mental Capacity Act (Northern Ireland) 2016(2), makes the following Regulations:

#### Citation and commencement

- 1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Mental Capacity (Deprivation of Liberty) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2019 and shall come into operation on 1st October 2019
- (2) In these Regulations "the principal Regulations" means the Mental Capacity (Deprivation of Liberty) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2019(3).

#### Amendment to the principal Regulations

2. After regulation 20 of the principal Regulations insert—


"20A. An exception certificate must be made on Form 10."
