Made--15th July 2020Coming into operation-10th August 2020

The Department of Health( $\mathbf{a}$ ), in exercise of the powers conferred by Article 64(2) of the Mental Health (Northern Ireland) Order 1986( $\mathbf{b}$ ), makes the following Order:

#### **Citation and commencement**

**1.** This Order may be cited as the Mental Health (1986 Order) (Amendment No. 2) Order 2020 and shall come into operation on 10th August 2020.

#### Amendment of Article 64(1)(b) of the Mental Health (Northern Ireland) Order 1986

**2.** In Article 64(1)(b)(c), for "six months" substitute "three months".
