# The Homeless Persons (Unsuitable Accommodation) (Scotland) Amendment Order 2017

Made - - - - 29th August 2017 Laid before the Scottish Parliament - - - 31st August 2017

Coming into force - - 2nd October 2017

The Scottish Ministers make the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by section 29(3) and (4) of the Housing (Scotland) Act 1987(1) and all other powers enabling them to do so.

#### Citation and commencement

**1.** This Order may be cited as the Homeless Persons (Unsuitable Accommodation) (Scotland) Amendment Order 2017 and comes into force on 2nd October 2017.

### Amendment of the Homeless Persons (Unsuitable Accommodation) (Scotland) Order 2014

- **2.**—(1) The Homeless Persons (Unsuitable Accommodation) (Scotland) Order 2014(2) is amended as follows.
  - (2) In article 7(2) (temporary accommodation) for "14" substitute "7".

This Order amends the Homeless Persons (Unsuitable Accommodation) (Scotland) Order 2014 to reduce the period of time, during which accommodation can be provided which would otherwise be unsuitable, from 14 to 7 days.
