The Nominet website contains extensive guidance as to how a complainant may state its case and support it with appropriate evidence. The Complainant has however described the circumstances surrounding this Complaint as it sees them, but has offered no evidence to support the proposition that it has Rights in a name which is identical or similar to the Domain Name. Nor is evidence submitted to back up its assertion that the Domain Name is an Abusive Registration in the Respondent's hands.

The only document to accompany the Complaint is a Land Registry transfer of registered title to a property at the direction of joint administrative receivers. The transferee is a company of which the named Complainant in this matter forms a part. This document is of little probative value in relation to the questions of rights and abusive registration set out above.

8. Decision

I refuse the Complainant's application for a summary decision. The domain name registration will therefore remain with the Respondent.
