In accordance with Rule 17A of the Tribunal Procedure (Upper Tribunal) Rules 2008 Mr Nasimul Hasan (IA/28817/2014) and Ms Nafisa Ali (IA/28830/2014) have been granted indefinite leave to remain in the United Kingdom and in those circumstances the Secretary of State's appeals are treated as abandoned pursuant to Section 104(4A) of the Nationality, Immigration and Asylum Act 2002.
- 3. Further, in accordance with Rule 17 of Tribunal Procedure (Upper Tribunal) Rules 2008, the Secretary of State has formally given notice of the withdrawal of her appeals in respect of NY (IA/28839/2014) and HY (IA/28810/2014).
