NOTICE OF WITHDRAWAL AND REASONS FOR THE TRIBUNAL GIVING CONSENT

- 1. The appellant through his representatives requested leave to withdraw his appeal against the decision of the First-tier Tribunal which had dismissed his appeal in a determination promulgated on 17th March 2015. He was granted permission to appeal that decision on 9th June 2015.
