# NOTICE OF WITHDRAWAL AND REASONS FOR THE TRIBUNAL GIVING CONSENT

- The Secretary of State is the appellant before the Upper Tribunal. She obtained permission to appeal to the Upper Tribunal against a decision of the First-tier Tribunal promulgated on 7 September 2015 allowing Mr Lal's appeal.
