DECISION AND REASONS

This is an appeal by the Secretary of State against the decision of First-Tier 1. Tribunal Judge Harris who on 4 January 2017 allowed the appeal of Mr Opara on human rights grounds. Permission to appeal was granted and thus the appeal came before me on the above date.

2. Ms Ahmed, the Senior Home Office Presenting Officer, told me that it was accepted that the Judge had been entitled to consider the evidence he had considered and sought leave to withdraw the appeal. There was no opposition to that application.
