DECISION AND REASONS

- 1. The Appellant is a national of Pakistan born on the 3rd October 1989. On the 21st February 2017 his appeal under the Immigration (European Economic Area) Regulations 2006 was dismissed by the First-tier Tribunal on the grounds that pursuant to the decision in <u>Sala (EFMs: right of appeal)</u> [2016] UKUT 00411 (IAC) there was no jurisdiction.
- 2. Permission to appeal was granted by Upper Tribunal Judge O'Connor on the 18th December 2017. Judge O'Connor indicated that the Upper Tribunal was minded, following the decision in <u>Khan v Secretary of State for the Home Department</u> [2017] EWCA Civ 1755 to find an error of law and remit the matter for hearing *de novo* before the First-tier Tribunal. Judge O'Connor directed that this would be the final

- disposal of the matter in the Upper Tribunal unless submissions were received to the contrary within 7 working days of his decision being sent.
- 3. No such representations having been received I therefore set the decision of the First-tier Tribunal aside and remit the matter for hearing *de novo* in the First-tier Tribunal.
