DETERMINATION AND REASONS

- 1) In a "Decision on Error of Law and Further Directions" issued on 19 November 2021 Upper Tribunal Judge Macleman determined that the First-tier Tribunal had erred in law and set aside its decision.
- 2) He also gave Directions inviting representation on the proper disposal of the appeal.
