## **DECISION AND REASONS**

- 1. Pursuant to rule 34 of the Tribunal Procedure (Upper Tribunal) Rules 2008 I have determined this appeal without a hearing.
- 2. The Respondent agrees that the First-tier Tribunal erred by not considering all of the documents including witness statements.
- 3. The parties were invited to indicate if either of them objected to an order remitting the case to be redetermined in the First-tier Tribunal. The Appellant consented. The Respondent did not act in response to the invitation but, as it was prompted by the Rule 24 notice, their consent can be inferred.
- 4. In the circumstances I find that the First-tier Tribunal erred in law. I set aside its decision and I direct that the appeal be redetermined in the First-tier Tribunal.
