JUDGMENT

The complaints of unfair dismissal and redundancy payment are struck out.

REASONS

- 1. The claimant complains of unfair dismissal and failure to pay a redundancy payment.
- 2. Sections 108 and 155 of the Employment Rights Act 1996 requires a claimant to have not less than two years' service to make an unfair dismissal or redundancy payment complaint.
- 3. The claimant was employed by the respondent for less than two years.
- 4. Therefore the claimant is not entitled to bring such complaints.
- 5. The claimant has failed to give an acceptable reason, despite being given the opportunity to do so, why the complaints should not be struck out.
- 6. Accordingly, the complaints of unfair dismissal and redundancy payment are struck out. The claimant's other complaints are not affected by this judgment.

The remaining claims remain listed for a Hearing on 15 March 2019 at 10 a.m.
