JUDGMENT

Employment Tribunals Rules of Procedure 2013 – Rule 21

The First Claimant (Mrs P Taylor)

- 1. The Claimant was dismissed in breach of contract in respect of notice and the Respondent is ordered to pay damages to her in the net sum of £234.00, having accounted for earnings that she has received in other employment during her notice period.
- 2. The Claimant was dismissed by reason of redundancy and is entitled to a redundancy payment of £2,114.00.
- 3. The Respondent has failed to pay the Claimant's holiday entitlement and is ordered to pay her the sum of £292.84.

The Second Claimant (Mrs P Foot)

- 4. The Claimant was dismissed in breach of contract in respect of notice and the Respondent is ordered to pay damages to her in the net sum of £375.84, having accounted for earnings that she has received in other employment during her notice period.
- 5. The Claimant was dismissed by reason of redundancy and is entitled to a redundancy payment of £2,912.76.
- 6. The Respondent has failed to pay the Claimant's holiday entitlement and is ordered to pay her the sum of £295.97.
- 7. The hearing listed on 12 July 2019 is cancelled.
