## **JUDGMENT**

The judgment of the Tribunal is that:

- 1 The claimant's claims that the respondent made unauthorised deductions from her wages, failed to pay to her holiday pay due on termination of employment, and that it breached her contract regarding notice of termination, are not well-founded, fail, and are dismissed.
- 2 The claimant's claim that the respondent failed to automatically enrol her in an occupational pension scheme is dismissed as the tribunal does not have jurisdiction (alleged non-compliance with applicable legislation being a matter for the Pensions Regulatory Authority).
