## JUDGMENT

- 1. It is declared that the Claimant was dismissed from his employment with the Respondent by reason of redundancy.
- 2. The claim to a statutory redundancy payment is well founded and succeeds.
- 3. The claim for unlawful deduction from wages is well founded and succeeds.
- 4. The claim for breach of contract relative to non-payment of notice pay is well founded and succeeds.
- 5. The claim under the Working Time Regulations 1998 in respect of accrued and unpaid holiday pay is well founded and succeeds.
- 6. The Respondent is ordered to pay to the Claimant by way of compensation the following net sums:

6.1	Statutory Redundancy Payment:	£6,040.12;
6.2	Notice pay (12 weeks)	£4140.80;
6.3	Arrears of pay (1 week)	£345.15; and
6.4	Accrued holiday pay <b>Total</b>	£345.15 <b>£10,871.22</b>

7. It is recorded that the Employment Protection (Jobseeker's Allowance etc) Regulations 1996 do not apply to any part of this award.
