JUDGMENT AT A PRELIMINARY HEARING

- 1. The complaint of age discrimination is struck out on the grounds that it is not actively pursued and it has no reasonable prospect of success.
- 2. The complaint of sexual orientation discrimination is struck out on the ground that it has no reasonable prospect of success.
- 3. This paragraph relates to the claimant's complaint that she was subjected to detriments on the ground that she made protected disclosures on 8 and 19 October 2018 about the conduct of a colleague. That complaint is struck out on the ground that it has no reasonable prospect of success.
- 4. The tribunal does not strike out the claimant's complaint of indirect discrimination by a principal in relation to religion and belief.
