#### **JUDGMENT**

# The judgment of the tribunal is that:

- 1 Pursuant to Section 111(2) of the Employment Rights Act 1996, the claimant's claim was presented in time.
- 2 The claimant was unfairly dismissed by the respondent on 31 July 2019.
- The claimant's claim for unpaid notice pay is well-founded.
- There is an award of compensation to the claimant, payable by the respondent in the sum of £4992.18 calculated as follows: -
