JUDGMENT ON A PRELIMINARY ISSUE

1. The claimant's application to amend his claim is refused.
2. The tribunal has jurisdiction to hear the claims presented to the employment tribunal in that:
 - a. The claimant has made a service complaint in respect of the claims before the employment tribunal.
 - b. The claimant's claims were presented to the employment tribunal within such a period as the tribunal finds just and equitable.
3. The claimant's claim of discrimination on the grounds of religion is dismissed upon withdrawal by the claimant.
