JUDGMENT

- 1. The claims of constructive unfair dismissal and harassment contrary to section 26 of the Equality Act 2010 were presented 9 years and 6 months out of time.
- 2. It was reasonably practicable for the claim of constructive unfair dismissal to have been presented within time, and it was not presented within a reasonable period after the expiry of the primary time limit. The Tribunal does not therefore have jurisdiction to hear the claims.
- 3. It would not be just and equitable to extend time to permit the claims of harassment to presented. The primary cause of the delay was the Claimant's belief that she would lose the claim because her account would be considered against that of four individuals who she says harassed her. The balance of prejudice favours the Respondent because it no longer has any means of contacting the individuals against whom the allegations are made.
- 4. The claims are therefore dismissed.
