JUDGMENT

UPON the Respondent failing to attend or be represented at this hearing,

AND UPON first considering the information available, the tribunal proceeded to hear the claim in the absence of the Respondent under Rule 47 of the Employment Tribunal Rules of Procedure 2013.

The judgment of the tribunal is that the Claimant succeeds in her claim for breach of contract and for payment of accrued but unpaid holiday pay and the Respondent is ordered to pay the Claimant the gross sum of £841.50 (made up of one day's pay shortfall in notice (£76.50) and 10 days accrued but unpaid holiday (10 x £76.50 = £765)).

And, for failure to give a written statement of particulars of employment the Respondent is ordered to pay the Claimant the sum of £612 (two weeks' pay).
