## JUDGMENT

- 1. It is declared that the Respondent has made an unauthorised deduction from the Claimant's wages by not paying her the sums due upon termination of employment on 15<sup>tH</sup> June 2019 as and when they fell due.
- 2. Because those sums were however paid on 15<sup>th</sup> July 2019 there is no order for compensation due under section 24 (1) (a) of the Employment Rights Act 1996, and that part of the claim is dismissed upon withdrawal.
- 3. The Respondent is ordered to pay to the Claimant £298.47, which is an appropriate sum to compensate her for financial loss attributable to that late payment, under section 24 (2) of the Employment Rights Act 1996.
- 4. The Claimant was unfairly dismissed. The claim is well founded.
- 5. The Respondent is ordered to pay to the Claimant compensation for unfair dismissal, calculated as follows:
  - 5.1 Basic award (2 weeks pay @ £131.36) £262.72
    5.2 Loss of earnings for 31 weeks from 1<sup>st</sup> July 2019 to 31<sup>st</sup> January 2020 £4047.16
    5.3 Loss of statutory rights £300.00
    5.4 An increase to the compensatory award of 7.5 % under section 207A Trades Union and Labour Relations (Consolidation) Act 1992 for unreasonably failing to comply with the ACAS Code of Practice on Disciplinary Procedures
