JUDGMENT

1. The names of the respondents are Thomas Berry and Natasha Ward t/a The Lime Leaf and the name of the respondent is amended accordingly by the consent of the parties.
2. The claimant was not unfairly dismissed by the respondents.
3. The claimant was dismissed in breach of a contract of employment. The respondents are ordered to pay the claimant damages of £79.63.
4. The respondents failed to pay the claimant the amount due to her under Regulation 14 of the Working Time Regulations 1998. The respondents are ordered to pay the claimant £138.07.
5. The respondents did not make unlawful deductions from the claimant's wages.
