JUDGMENT

My Judgment is that:-

- 1. The claimant was dismissed.
- 2. That dismissal was unfair.
- 3. The claimant did not contribute to the dismissal.
- 4. The claimant is awarded a basic award of £3150.
- 5. The compensatory award reflects 9 weeks loss of pay at £650.34 per week (£5853.06) and pension loss for the same period at £37.98 per week (£341.82) and so the total of the compensatory award is £6194.88.
- 6. It is just and equitable to make an uplift as a lower award under the provisions of the Employment Act 2002 section 38. For these purposes the week's pay is capped at £525 and so the uplift is £1050.

7. Accordingly, the total award to the claimant now payable forthwith by the respondent is £10394.88.
