JUDGMENT

It is the unanimous judgment of the Tribunal that:

1. The claim of discrimination arising from disability advanced pursuant to sections 15 and 39(2) of the Equality Act 2010 is well-founded and the claimant is entitled to a remedy

2. The claim of unfair dismissal advanced pursuant to sections 94/98 of the Employment Rights Act 1996 is well-founded and the claimant is entitled to a remedy.

3. Terms of settlement on remedy having been agreed and noted on the Tribunal file, this matter stands adjourned until 4:00pm on 3 October 2020 to enable those terms of settlement on remedy to be carried into effect. If neither party applies to the Tribunal to restore the matter for a Remedy Hearing by that time and date, the question of remedy arising from this Judgment will stand dismissed without further order.
