## **JUDGMENT**

- 1. The claimant's unfair dismissal claim is well-founded.
- 2. The respondent is ordered to pay the claimant £31,434.89 made up as follows:
  - 2.1 a basic award of **£3,150**;
  - 2.2 past loss of earnings from 28 September 2019 to 17 November 2020 of £17,930.85;
  - future loss of earnings from 18 November 2020 to 31 March 2021 of £1,400;
  - 2.4 loss of pension contributions of £3,906.56;
  - 2.5 an ACAS uplift of 20% on £23,237.41, £4,647.48; and
  - 2.5 loss of statutory rights in the sum of £400.
- 3. There is no reference to the claimant having claimed recoupable state benefits.
