JUDGMENT

The claimant's complaint was struck out pursuant to rule 37(1)(a) of the Employment Tribunals Rules of Procedure 2013 on the grounds that the claim has no reasonable prospect of success. The claimant made a claim of unfair dismissal pursuant to section 94 and 98 of the Employment Rights Act 1996. The claimant did not have two years qualifying employment as required by section 108(1) and the provisions of section 108 (3) did not apply.
