1. The claim is dismissed.

REASONS

- 1. On 24 October 2020 the Tribunal wrote to the Claimant to inform him that an Employment Judge was considering striking out the claim because it has not been actively pursued.
- 2. The Claimant was given 21 days to object to this proposal and give reasons in writing or request a hearing at which he could make them.
- 3. The Claimant has not responded to the Tribunal's letter.
- 4. The claim is therefore dismissed because it has not been actively pursued.
