## **JUDGMENT**

- 1. The complaint of unauthorised deduction from wages in respect of the fine of £125 was not presented within the time limit set out in s23 Employment Rights Act 1996 and it was reasonably practicable to do so. That complaint is therefore dismissed.
- 2. The complaint of unauthorised deductions from wages in respect of the disputed overnight subsistence payments amounting to £60 is not well founded and is dismissed.
- 3. All other complaints are well founded and succeed.
- 4. By consent, the Respondent shall pay the Claimant: £798 outstanding wages, £742 outstanding holiday pay and £20 outstanding subsistence allowance.
