JUDGMENT

- 1. The claimant's claim for a protective award under section 189 of the Trade Union & Labour Relations (Consolidation) Act 1992 ("TULRA") is wellfounded and succeeds.
- 2. The Tribunal makes a declaration under section 189(2) TULRA that the Respondent has failed to comply with its duty to consult appropriate representatives in accordance with section 188 TULRA.
- 3. The Tribunal determines that the protected period under section 189 (4) TULRA is 90 days.
- The respondent shall pay to the claim the sum of £8,838.00 (representing 4. 90 days' gross pay at a daily rate of £98.20).
