## JUDGMENT

1. The claimant's complaint of unauthorised deduction from wages is well-founded and succeeds. The respondent is ordered to pay to the claimant the sum of £228.45 in respect of wages unlawfully deducted. That is a net amount and the respondent should be responsible for the payment of any income tax and national insurance contributions thereon.
2. By consent, the title of these proceedings is amended to show the correct name of the respondent as Bescol Motors (Consett) Limited.
