**Employment Tribunals Rules of Procedure 2013 – Rule 21** 

- 1. The Claimant was unfairly dismissed by the Respondent. The Respondent is ordered to pay the Claimant £550 in respect of loss of statutory rights.
- 2. The Respondent has failed to pay the Claimant's holiday entitlement and is ordered to pay the Claimant the net sum of £3,120.
- 3. The Claimant was dismissed in breach of contract in respect of notice and the Respondent is ordered to pay damages to him in the sum of £1,040.
