JUDGMENT

The judgment of the Tribunal is that:

Respondent:

- 1. the Claimant's claim in respect of accrued, but untaken, holiday (Reg 14, WTR 1998) is dismissed on withdrawal;
- 2. the Claimant did not undertake like work, by comparison with the work undertaken by her male comparator, and the Respondent did not breach the implied sex equality clause (s.66 EqA);
- 3. the Claimant's claim that the Respondent failed to make reasonable adjustments (s.20 EqA) is not well-founded, and is dismissed;
- 4. the Claimant's claim that the Respondent treated her unfavourably because of something arising in consequence of her disability (s.15 EqA) is not well-founded, and is dismissed
- 5. the Claimant was not constructively dismissed.
