JUDGMENT

- 2. The Claimant must provide a schedule of loss, supporting documents and witness statement by **16 November 2020**. Remedy will be dealt with on the papers if possible and at a further hearing otherwise.
- 3. The Respondent is entitled to receive copies of documents and notice of any hearing but may only participate to the extent permitted by an Employment Judge.
