JUDGMENT

The response is struck out.

REASONS

- 1. By a letter dated the 9th of September 2022 the Tribunal gave the respondent an opportunity to make representations or to request a hearing, as to why the response should not be struck out because:
 - The respondent had not complied with the Order of the Tribunal dated 24th of March 2022.
 - It has not been actively pursued.
- 2. The respondent has failed to make representations in writing, or has failed to make any sufficient representations, why this should not be done or to request a hearing. The response is therefore struck out.
