JUDGMENT

- The complaint of unauthorised deduction from wages is dismissed following a withdrawal by the claimant. The claimant's remaining complaints will proceed to hearing on a date to be notified in due course.
- The respondent's application to strike out the claimant's claim is refused.
- The claimant's application to postpone the final hearing is granted.
- The respondent's application for costs of the postponement in the form of the costs incurred in attending the tribunal on 28 April 2022 is refused.
- The respondent is awarded the costs/preparation time that will be incurred in updating the hearing bundle to incorporate the claimant's documents and in preparing supplementary/rebuttal witness statements in response to the claimant's witness statements. The amount of the costs/preparation time will be assessed by the Tribunal at the final hearing, to ensure that the sum claimed was properly incurred and is reasonable and proportionate. The Tribunal will also be at liberty to take into account, if and to the extent the Tribunal considers it appropriate to do so, the Claimant's means when assessing the amount of the award.
