JUDGMENT

1. The Claimant's claim for unlawful deductions from wages against the first Respondent is dismissed.
2. The first Respondent, Artemis Recruitment, was in breach of contract by failing to pay the required notice period. The respondent is ordered to pay to the claimant the gross sum of £2,000, representing 1 weeks' notice pay, being damages for the breach of contract.
3. The Claimant's claim for unlawful deductions from wages against the second Respondent, The Regenerative Clinic, is dismissed on a withdrawal by the Claimant.
4. The Claimant's claim for breach of contract for unpaid notice pay against the second Respondent, The Regenerative Clinic, is dismissed on a withdrawal by the Claimant.
