JUDGMENT

Neither party having attended the hearing proceeded pursuant to rule 47 of the Employment Tribunal Rules of Procedure.

Having considered the claim, response, and the documentary material / correspondence available on the Tribunal's file I reached the following judgment on the balance of probabilities.

- 1. It is declared that the Respondent did make a deduction from the Claimant's wages in contravention of s13 Employment Rights Act 1996 in respect of work done between 21st October 2021 and 20th November 2021. Specifically, only half of the wages due were paid to the Claimant.
- 2. The Respondent is ordered to pay to the Claimant the amount of the deduction, being £776.15 gross. This sum is gross and the Respondent is responsible for making any appropriate payments to HMRC.
