JUDGMENT

The Employment Judge gave Judgment as follows;

- 1. The Respondent has made an unauthorised deduction from the Claimant's wages and must pay the Claimant in the sum of £8333.33 gross.
- 2. The Claimant was dismissed in breach of contract in respect of notice and the Respondent must pay damages to the Claimant in the sum of £25,000.00.
- **3.** The Claimant was dismissed by reason of redundancy and is entitled to redundancy payment in the sum of £1713.00.
- 4. The Respondent has failed to pay the Claimant's holiday entitlement and must pay the Claimant **the sum of £10384.58**.
- 5. The Respondent has made an authorised deduction from the Claimant's wages in respect of pension contributions and must pay the Claimant a further **sum of £293.52 gross**.
