JUDGMENT

- 1. The Claimant's application to strike out the Response under Rule 37(1)(b) and (c) of the Employment Tribunals Rules of Procedure 2013 is refused.
- 2. The Claimant was unfairly dismissed by the Respondent.
- 3. The claim for breach of contract in respect of notice pay is well founded.
- 4. The claim for a statutory redundancy payment is dismissed on withdrawal.
- 5. The Respondent shall pay the following sums to the Claimant:
 - 1) A basic award of £2000.
 - 2) A compensatory award of £717.
 - 3) An award for breach of contract (notice pay) of £1792.50.
 - 4) There will be an uplift of 20% to the compensatory award and the award for notice pay for the Respondent's unreasonable failure to comply with the ACAS Code on Discipline and Grievances. This amounts to £501.90.
- 6. The total award is therefore £5011.40.
- 7. The Employment Protection (Recoupment of Benefits) Regulations 1996 do not apply to this award.
