- 2. The Claimant's complaint that the Respondent breach duty to provide written particulars of employment is made out and allowed.
- 3. The Respondent's contract claim is not made out and is dismissed.
- 4. The Respondent must pay the Claimant the sum of £2,731.57, calculated as follows:

5. In respect of Paragraphs 4.1, 4.2 & 4.3, the Respondent is entitled to deduct any tax and employee's national insurance contributions due on
