JUDGMENT

Employment Tribunals Rules of Procedure 2013 – Rule 21

- 1. The claim was issued on 27 July 2021 and the respondent failed to present a valid response on time. A determination of the claim was therefore made in accordance with Rule 21 of the Rules of Procedure.
- The claimant was dismissed by reason of redundancy and is entitled to a statutory redundancy payment of £923.08 (£461.54 gross salary per week x 2 weeks)
- 3. The claimant was dismissed in breach of contract in respect of notice and the respondent must pay damages to the claimant of £738.46 (£369.23 net per week x 2 weeks)
- 4. The respondent has unlawfully deducted payments in respect of holiday pay and must pay the claimant £4,135.38 (£369.23 net x 11.2 weeks)
- 5. The respondent has unlawfully deducted payments in respect of furlough pay and must pay the claimant £7,680 (£640 net x 12 months)
